Consent for Private Property Services: Safety for All

This Consent enables the licensed security provider ("security contractor") contracted by Central Eastside Together, Central Eastside Industrial Council (CEIC)'s Enhanced Service District (ESD) program.

Services

The goal of the Safety for All program is for the security contractor to provide innovative, district-wide safety services as part of Central Eastside Together's Safety for All. With or without this consent, the security contractor will uphold the law with regards to private property but verbally intervene in all situations that appear unlawful on private property. Services will be provided in the following areas:

- Northern Boundary: The south side of I-84 between the Willamette River and east side of SE 12th Avenue;
• Southern Boundary: SE Division Place, north side between I-99 and Willamette River; SE Division Street, including the properties on the south side between SE Grand and SE 10th Avenues; both sides between SE 10th and SE 12th Avenues; and SE Hawthorne, including the properties on the south side between SE 10th and SE 11th Avenues, and north side between SE 11th and SE 12th Avenues;
• Eastern Boundary: SE 10th Avenue, west side between SE Hawthorne Blvd and SE Division Street; SE 12th Avenue, west side between I-84 and SE Stark Street; including the properties on the east side between SE Stark Street and SE Hawthorn Blvd; I-99, west side between SE Division Place and SE Division Street; and
• Western Boundary: Willamette River, between I-84 and north side of SE Division Place.
• Properties immediately on both sides of SE Division Street between SE 10th and SE 12th Avenues and the area within the west side of SE 12th Ave between SE Division Street and SE Ivon Street.
• 1401 SE Morrison Street.

Consent

With a signature below from the owner, or legally designated owner representative, this consent enables the security contractor to act on the property owner's behalf to address trespassers or other issues on their property located in the district. The security contractor will intervene verbally with anyone trespassing on private property and will contact police as needed to resolve situations while also providing detailed documentation of incidents. The security contractor will only provide these additional services on the exterior of private property structures. If the security contractor officer comes upon an interior crime-in-progress, the security contractor will contact the police but not enter the property. Because this consent falls under the CEIC's contract with the security contractor, no separate payment is required.
