

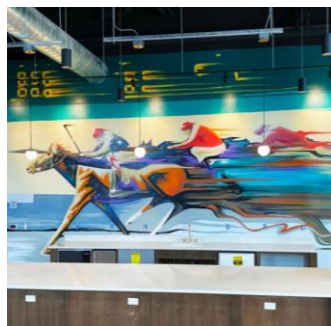
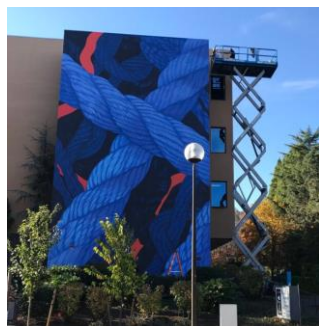
COMMISSIONED SERVICES

- We reach out to artists that you like the best, gathering quotes
- Once the artist is chosen, we will develop a contract
- The artist provides concept sketches and site mock-ups, and we help managed the feedback and revision process
- We help manage artist communications and assist with site logistics
- We ensure the project is completed according to specifications, on-time, and within budget
- We provide liability insurance for all the artists we work with
- We help secure city mural permits and host community meetings, as needed
- We help promote the project via social media and press releases, when appropriate
