



Monthly Report October 2022

Highlights from October 2022:

- The Safety for All team responded to 221 dispatches from 103 unique businesses.
- The Care team supported 2 people applying to permanent housing. The team spent 27 hours working on case management involving housing & shelter support this month.
- The Safety and Care teams were both down one staff member but successfully maintained service hours. October trainings included a de-escalation refresher, Professional Boundaries and Ethics discussion, and a presenter from Adult Protective Services to discuss their program.
- The Cleaning teams removed 77,280 pounds of trash & 1,301 needles.

- In October, Central Eastside Together Staff:
 - Hosted the October Central Eastside Together Board meeting.
 - Met with Portland Street Art Alliance to discuss mural projects in the District and the challenges they face. Discussed how PSAA & CET can connect in the future to promote murals and public art as a part of Placemaking projects and how CET services can support private murals,
 - Supported a CEIC-presented public forum on the Charter Reform ballot measure.
 - Convened Community Grants Committee to review and decide which projects to fund. Chosen applicants were the Native Arts and Culture Center, Hygeine4All, and Portland Street Medicine.
 - Met with the Bureau of Environmental Services and Trash For Peace to continue planning and problem-solving for the Bioswales project.
 - Attended Downtown Clean & Safe Retail Safety Summit.
 - Worked to improve Safety & Care program reporting metrics and capability.
 - Coordinated Safety Hub meeting between neighbors looking to create shared plan of increasing safety and cleanliness.
