Funding Priorities + Objectives:

Community Building, Environment &	 Address safety and cleaning concerns in the district through creative, innovative and eco-friendly solutions.
Citizen Engagement	 Create public community events that engage and / or promote local business and inclusivity.
Placemaking	Enhance the district identity and walkability.
	 Enhance district identity and awareness through innovative arts and cultural projects in public space.
Workforce Development	 Implement innovative workforce development programs that directly serve businesses in the Central Eastside.
	 Create work opportunities in the district for vulnerable populations.
Houseless Services	 Support or improve community-based health and wellness programs.
	 Expand access to basic human needs including but not limited to housing, food, safe sleeping, etc.
	 Promote work-based innovations that resulting in additional opportunity for the houseless community.

Evaluation Criteria:

Feasibility & Budget	 How feasible is the project based on the budget?
	Is the project matched from other sources? (Required)
(20%)	 Can the project be completed based on both the timeline and budget?
Innovation	 Is the project bringing something new to the district?
(20%)	 Does the project work to solve an issue in a creative and manageable way?
Community Engagement	 Does the project engage historically underrepresented and/ or vulnerable populations?
(20%)	 How much of the community will be engaged with the project?
	Does the project engage Central Eastside businesses?
