



Safety Ambassador Job Description

Business Liaison

- Prioritize response to dispatch calls to ensure rapid response meets business needs

Houseless Community Liaison

- Build rapport and trust with houseless individuals, doing welfare checks, offering resources and meeting immediate needs when possible by handing out water, granola bars, dog food, hand warmers and the like
- Assess needs and barriers to service for the purpose of helping connect houseless with services, with the help of the Outreach Ambassadors and Care Coordinator

Safety for All

- Stay visible and active at all times in the low barrier Safety Ambassador uniform
- Hand out Central Eastside Together magnets to everyone so they know how to request services
- Document every incident of biohazard, trash, abandoned autos and vandalism
- Make an entry for each new camp and update regularly to document size, movement and cleanliness
- Complete an entry for every business, resident, houseless individual or visitor spoken to or assisted with a Safety Escort
- Attend and engage fully in initial and ongoing professional development training
