Welcome / Introductions:

AChaillé welcomes the group to the meeting. This meeting is designed to allow for the TPAC to discuss the PBOT presentation from last week on the new Safe Streets Program. The goal will be to provide PBOT with recommendations.

Permit Sales

KAlldrin provides an update on parking permits in the Central Eastside. Permit sales are lower than expected. The group suggests that we need to allow for flexibility to permit sales.

SPearce motions to extend the application period to July 30 for permit sales in zone G and N to offer flexibility and remove the requirement that zone N permits must be renewed for permit year 2020 2021, TMcNerthy seconds the motion. Motion passes unanimously.

PBOT Safe Streets Presentation

DFunk suggests that we ask PBOT if we can see street closures that have applied before they are approved. The group agrees that this is important. KAlldrin says that will be made available to the TPAC.

TMcNerthy suggests that it would be helpful to see a map overlaid with permit applications and safe street applications and see where the overlap is. AZucker points out that getting a permit does not mean that you can secure a spot in front of your business. The group continues discussion around this topic.

KMerrill suggests that staff could review the overlaid map and when we see large amounts of overlap then we can do direct outreach and provide feedback to PBOT.

The group agrees that if there are lane or street closures the application must be shown to TPAC prior to approval.

The chair will accept a Motion to accept all the groups recommendation, SPearce makes a motion, CGosset seconds the motion. Motion passed unanimously.
